

OUTDOOR EDUCATION LIST

Outdoor Ed lockers will be used to store OE gear and supplies. Students are returning to wearing their uniforms fulltime! Check the "Weekly OE Packing List" page on the school website. (Hover over Student Life, then Parents, then click Outdoor Education).

Outdoor education activities and lessons require specific clothing or additional clothing at times. All students are required to keep outdoor gear at school in their outdoor education locker throughout the school year to insure their ability to participate. Students without proper gear will not be permitted to participate in activities and lessons. Keep in mind the items you choose to stock your child's outdoor gear bag with may get dirty and wet. Dress your child appropriately for the weather each day.

This will allow us to move outside more quickly, maximizing our learning opportunities. Outdoor gear is due the first week of school. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Winter Outdoor Gear List – Send to school by November 1, 2022

Hat – warm winter hat covering ears

Socks – 2 pairs long warm socks

Mittens or gloves – 1 pair medium weight
